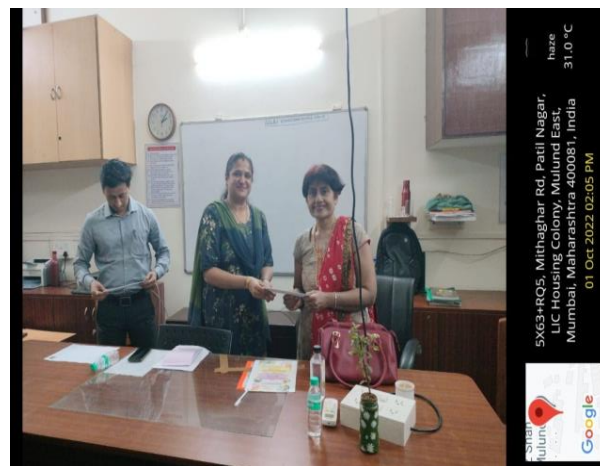
CULTURAL COMMITTEE 2022-23
