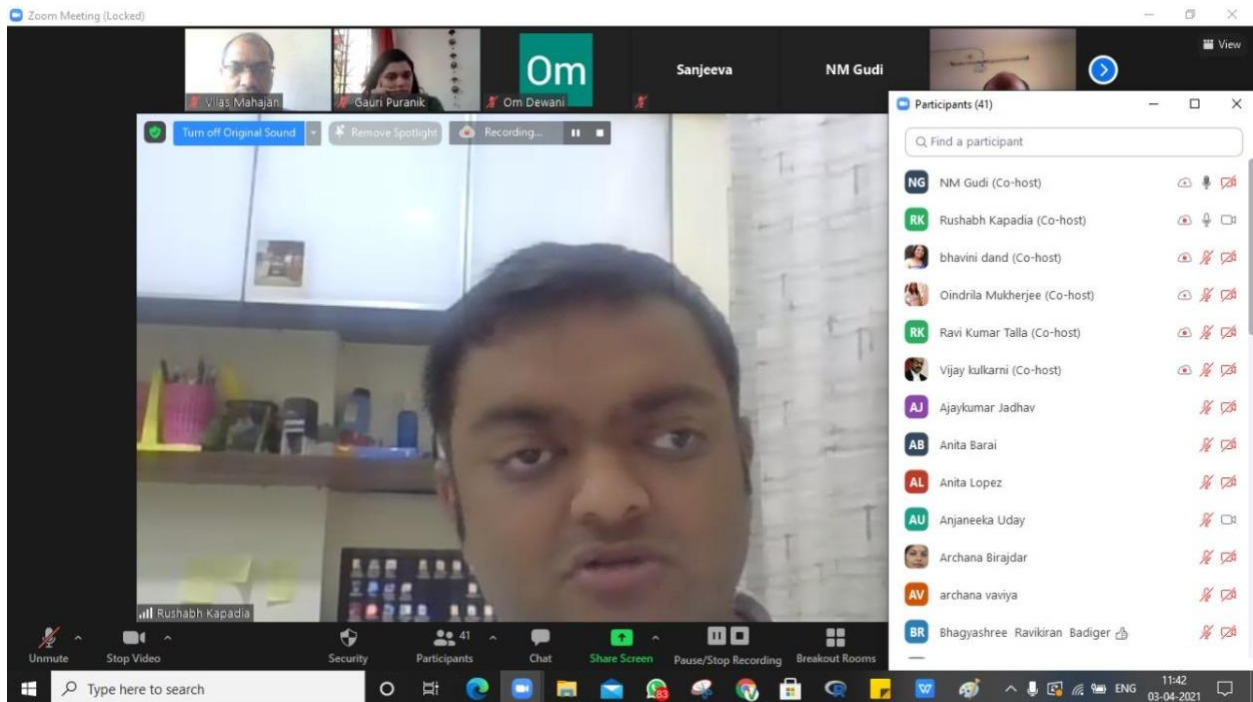

Report on webinar organized by entrepreneurial cell in association with IQAC of VPM's R.Z. Shah College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Mulund(E)

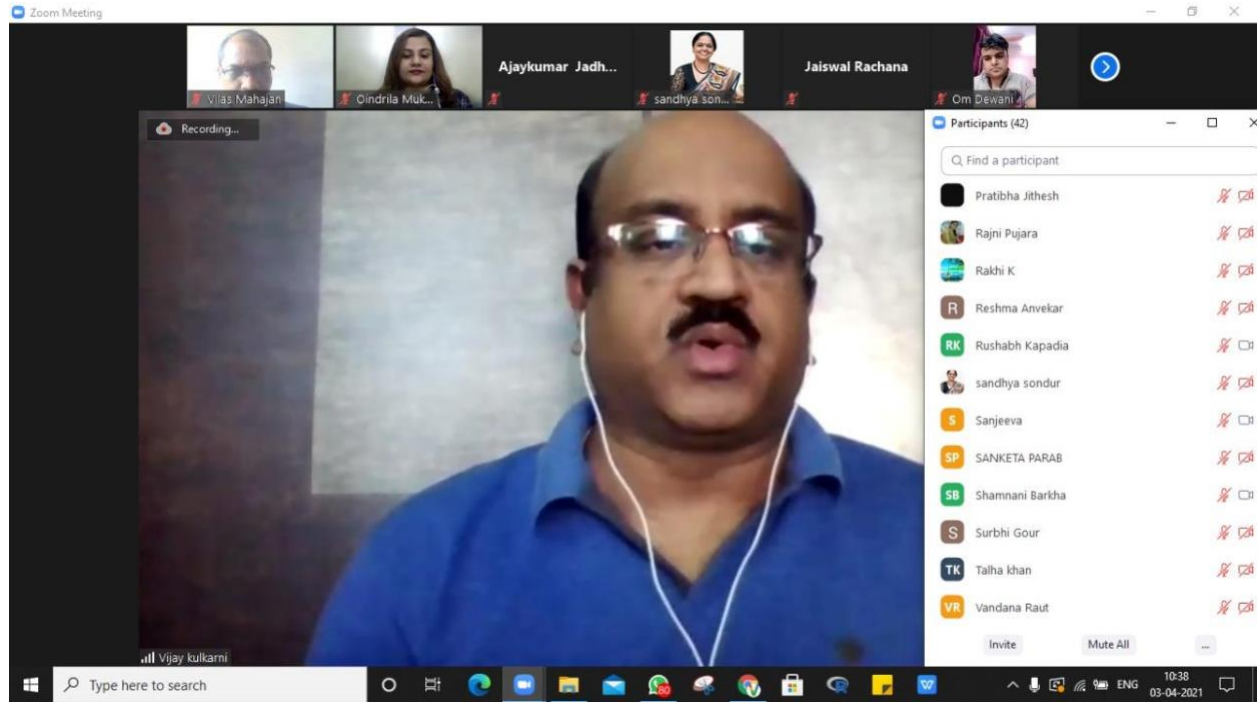
