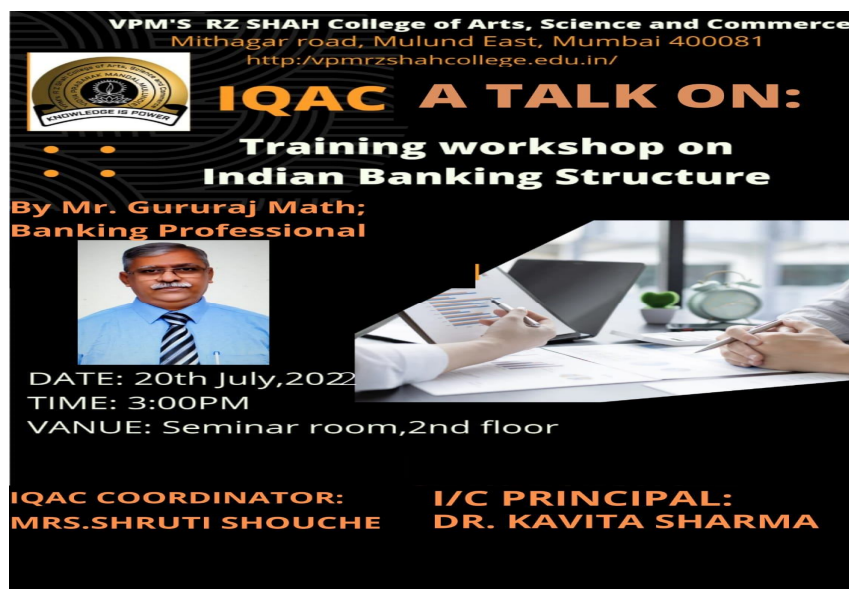


## Report on workshop for students on the topic 'Indian Banking Structure'
