With the same idea to spread Awareness among the present individuals, the Extension committee in association with Department of Commerce and Management of VPM's R Z SHAH COLLEGE organised a seminar on the topic of CONSUMER RIGHTS AND ACT FOR CONSUMER PROTECTION.





The programme started at 10:00 am with escorting the Guest Speaker Adv. Vijay Kulkarni Sir. With a heartwarming welcome to the Guest Speaker, In-charge Principal, Barkha Shamnani and Teacher co-ordinator, Dr. Bhavini Dand and everyone present over there at the moment the seminar began.

With felicitation of speaker by the In-charge Principal, the seminar began. Adv. Vijay Kulkarni commenced his talk by simply stating the difference between who is a consumer and who is not a consumer. He moved ahead explaining what are the roles and responsibilities of the consumer and as well as the sellers.
