The resource person for the program was Dr Deepak C. Nanaware. The programme started with the welcoming of the Guest Speaker by Ms. Aditi Chaubey, Faculty from Department of General Science.

The programme started at 11am with the session on "Practicing NEP-2-020 hands-on training on Course Outcome and Program outcome".

The Guest Speaker commenced the session by saying that being teachers, we need to understand the objectives of teaching. With students giving their precious time, we need to investigate whether or not they are really learning, review our teaching methodology, check whether the course outcome and program outcome really matches their level; if not then how to plan the entire Course outcome and Program outcome.

The honourable speaker gave full details about CO and PO and he spoke about the need to check the merits and demerits with the students and ascertain their learning by using the below mentioned methodologies in order to ensure Conceptual understanding of learning objectives and outcomes:

- Learning outcomes-based curriculum framework
- Guiding principles of writing CO, PO and PSO
- Mapping and assessment plan
- How to set assessment plan
- · Method of evaluation
- · Planning attainment

Dr Nanaware stressed on the teachers' need to determine what they want their learners to learn through their teaching. The key point of his address was that the quality of teaching is judged by the quality of the learning that takes place. He discussed each one of the aforementioned points with practical implementation.

The learned doctor also discussed the industrial revolution, Course objectives vs outcomes, types of learning outcomes, Bloom's Taxonomy, Low order thinking to High order thinking,

challenges faced while defining the course outcome, Action taken report, program outcome and program

specific outcome, and finally discussed in detail the complete assessment chart with practical implementation. He suggested that the actual implementation of CO and PO has to be done Department wise, it will also help us identify the exact location of the problem, the suffering subject, whether the teacher couldn't implement CO and PO or if the actual syllabus CO and PO were improperly framed. The analysis of the CO and PO has to be done periodically for proper implementation.

In conclusion, Dr Nanaware reiterated our need to frame CO and PO and teach its objectives to meet industry revolution 4.0 and 5.0. He quoted "Beginning of the end and the End of the beginning".

Dr Nanaware's elucidation was a highly motivating as well as a great learning experience for everyone. The Program ended with a vote of thanks by Ms. Virati from the Department of Arts.
