She cited Taj Trapezium Case (M. C. Mehta vs. Union of India) filed by the environmentalist M. C. Mehta in the Supreme Court of India in 1984, aimed to protect the Taj Mahal from pollution caused by industries in the vicinity. This case led to the formulation of stringent environmental regulations and the establishment of TTZ Authority to monitor and regulate industrial activities in the area. It set a precedent for using PIL as a tool for environmental protection and heritage preservation in India.

Guest of the event Mr. Prasanna Pandit also addressed the audience about the issues of climate change. The Guest speaker Madam in a very noble gesture donated the remuneration offered to her for the cause of Tree plantation in the college. The event ended with vote of thanks by Ms. Zeenat, Student Secretary of College Women Development Cell.
