

Talk was delivered by the Guest Speaker Adv. Grishma Lad and Guest of the event Mr. Prasanna Pandit. Hon. General Secretary Adv. Vijay Kulkarni graced the event with his presence. Ms. Riddhi welcomed and introduced the Guest speaker and Guest of the event. The Guest speaker Adv. Grishma Lad was felicitated by the Hon. General Secretary with a memento. In charge Principal Dr. Barkha Shamnani felicitated the Guest with a memento.

Adv. Grishma Lad delivered her talk on Climate change and Human Rights its recent trends, challenges and road ahead. She cited many case studies relevant to the topic.

She cited some significant Public Interest litigation cases for the comprehension of the student audience in a very lucid manner. She stated that public Interest Litigation (PIL) has been instrumental in addressing various social, environmental and governmental issues in India. The Taj mahal case as one of the landmark PIL cases concerning environmental conservation and heritage preservation.

She cited Taj Trapezium Case (M. C. Mehta vs. Union of India) filed by the environmentalist M. C. Mehta in the Supreme Court of India in 1984, aimed to protect the Taj Mahal from pollution caused by industries in the vicinity. This case led to the formulation of stringent environmental regulations and the establishment of TTA Authority to monitor and regulate industrial activities in the area. It set a precedent for using PIL as a tool for environmental protection and heritage preservation in India.

Guest of the event Mr. Prasanna Pandit also addressed the audience about the issues of climate change. The Guest speaker Madam in a very noble gesture donated the remuneration offered to her for the cause of Tree plantation in the college. The event ended with vote of thanks by Ms. Zeenat, Student Secretary of College Women Development Cell.
